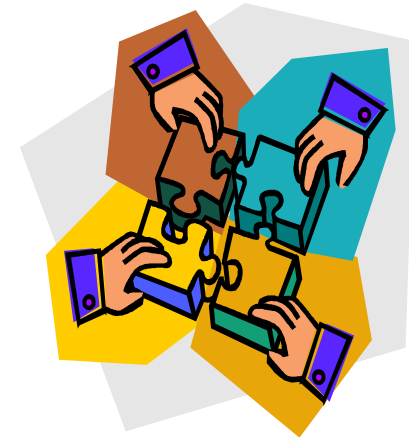

Why Small Groups?

- Jesus used small groups to teach and model His principles. Matthew 4:19
- We were created to experience life together, which is what the Body of Christ is all about. Acts 2:42
- There are some things you just can't do alone. Ecclesiastics 4:12

What does a Growth Group do?

- **Meets** together once a week for 10-12 weeks
- **Reaches** out together once a semester (servant evangelism)
- **Fellowships** together once a semester
- **Serves** together

Why have Growth Groups?

There are **BIG advantages** to belonging to this kind of community, which include:

- **You make friends faster**
- **Personal Spiritual growth** is more steady and consistent
- These groups **meet for 10-12 weeks** then they are over until the next semester
- **Less burnout** for the facilitators
- New **topics** each semester

What is a LifeGroup?

- A Life Group does "life together." They meet once or twice a month, doing fellowship, caring for one-another, learning and doing.
